

PETER SELLARS - SCENE D'AMOUR

At the dawn of the new millennium, the Châtelet Theatre in Paris staged the world premiere of an opera by American composer John Adams, El Niño. The opera is a contemporary version of the Nativity, based on the writings of such great Latin-American poets as Rosario Castellanos or Gabriela Mistral. Stage producer Peter Sellars talks of the difficulties inherent in a world premiere, where everything remains to be invented and discovered, within a very limited time span. The new opera is of astonishing musical colouring - particularly in a trio of counter-tenors - and it is interpreted by outstanding artists: Dawn Upshaw and Willard White.
