After "The Times of the Roman Empire", the second instalment of the collection looks at the most influential cultures that dominated the world around the year 800. While Charlemagne « invented » schools in Europe, universities and libraries have been known to exist in China and India for a long time already. On the other side of the Mediterranean, the Arab world very rapidly installed an empire, spreading a new religion and a new civilisation... This voyage back in time takes us from Aix-la-Chapelle to Chang'An in China, from Damascus to Marrakech or to Istanbul.
