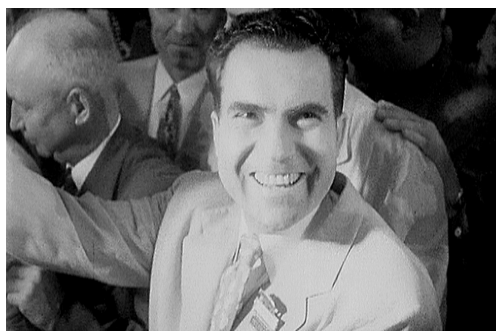

Richard Nixon was elected 37th President of the United States of America on November 6, 1968.
